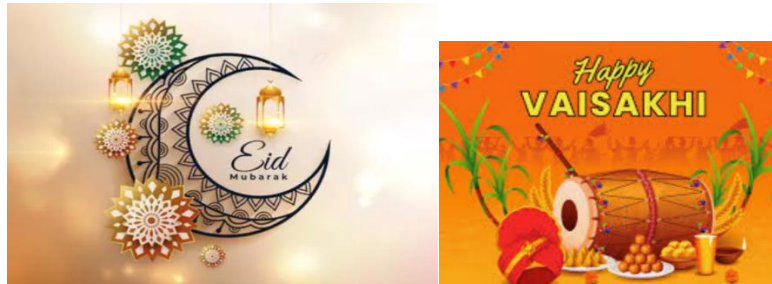


Dear Parents

LOWER PHASE NEWSLETTER

This week, year 1, 2 and 3 started the new term with an assembly on this week's value 'teamwork' We explored how we can use our teamwork skill in class and discussed the importance of all working together as a team to ensure our school is a happy and safe place to be.

In their classrooms, the children have been using their teamwork skills in a variety of lessons. On Thursday, year 2 worked in groups to practise their measuring skills. They had to work together to measure a range of items using scales and then used the information to compare the measurements. They have also started their new text 'Rapunzel' and worked in pairs to sequence the story and compare it to an alternate version.

Year 1 enjoyed using the Beebots to write and test simple programs. They had to work together to create an algorithm for the Beebot to follow and needed to think carefully about how to correct any errors they spotted. They have also started reading 'The Snail and the Whale' and have been using their oracy skills to retell the story to each other. In Year 3, the children have been taken back in time to Ancient Greece. They have started their work on this new topic and have been exploring Greek myths in their reading and English lessons.
